Adverse Rights of Military Service

has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Washington, District of Columbia, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Henry H. Hare*

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1830, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the first half of the North West quarter of section thirty four, township four north, range four west, in the District of Columbia, containing forty acre and four parts one hundred

and the balance were according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Henry Hare*

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said *Henry Hare*

the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said *Henry Hare*

and his heirs and assigns forever.
