whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Elijah Deal

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
the East half of the North West quarter, of Section thirteen, in Township twenty three, of Range one West in
the District of Tuscaloosa and State of Alabama, containing eighty acres, and four hundred and one
acres

according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Elijah Deal

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several
acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Elijah Deal, his heirs
the said tract above described. To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appur-
tenances, of whatever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said Elijah Deal
and to his heirs and assigns forever.
