according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said plat has been fur-

nished by the said Howell Chammons.

several acts of Congress in that case made and provided have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Howell

Howell Chammons

and its heirs and assigns forever.
