whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *William & Perry*

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

the East half of the North West quarter of section 16, Township 10 N., Range 10 E., in the District of Columbia, containing 160 acres

less and twenty down and a half hundredths of an acre

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-

chased by the said *William & Perry*

NOT KNOWING *that the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA*, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several

acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said *William & Perry*

the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appur-

tenances, of whatever nature thereto belonging, unto the said William & Perry

and their heirs and assigns forever, as tenants in common and not as joint tenants
