To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas Minor A Horton, of Shelby County, Alabama,

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of THE REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at Tuscaloosa, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Minor A Horton,

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the East half of the South West quarter, and the West half of the South East quarter of Section twenty six, in Township twenty one, of Range one, East, in the district of lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing one hundred and sixty acres,

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said Minor A Horton,

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Minor A Horton,

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Minor A Horton,

and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof J. James Buchanan, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, has caused these Letters to be made PATENT, and the SEAL of the GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
