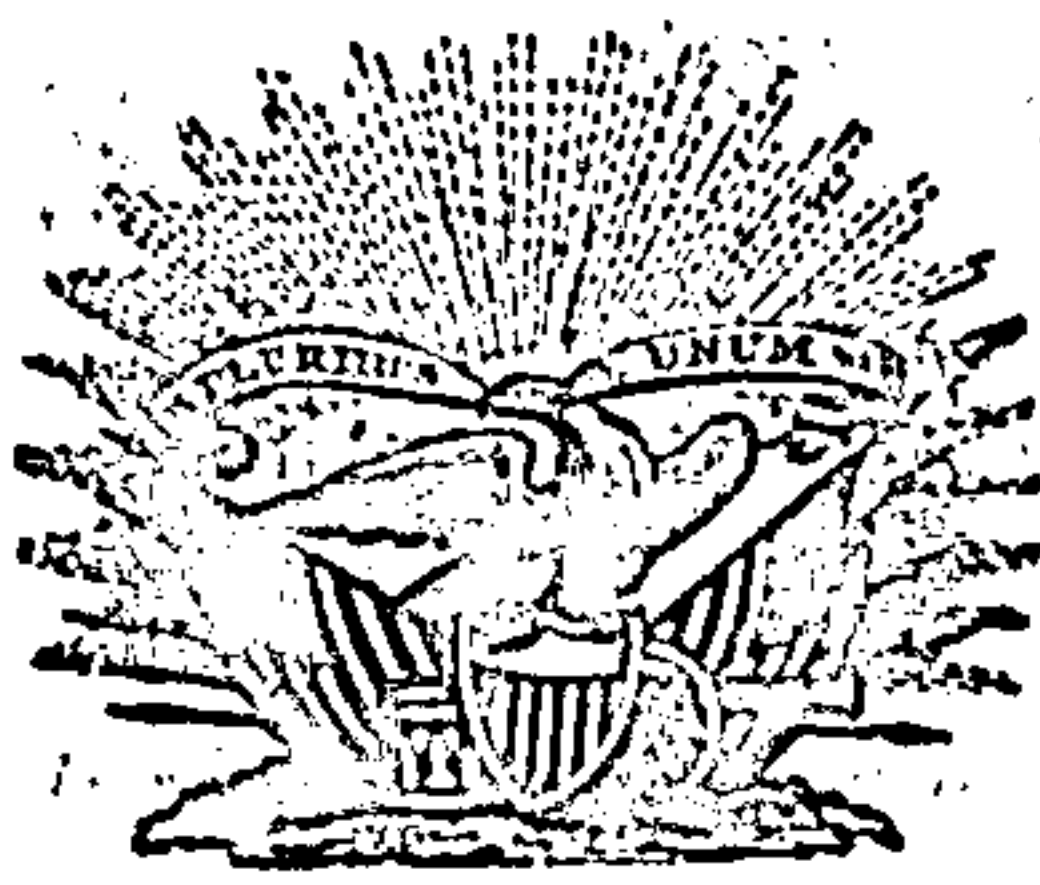


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The United States of America

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 10952 for 80 acres; issued in favor of Samuel Gilmore, First Lieutenant in Captain Paul's Company First Regiment Georgia Militia War of 1812

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the East Half of the South East quarter of Section One in Township Twenty One of Range one west in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama containing Eighty acres

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL: Which has been assigned to Henry H. Collier

Now know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Henry H. Collier

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Henry H. Collier and to his

heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I, Franklin Pierce PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
