THIS SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 25 day of February , 1953, by and between

SOUTHERN RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation of the State of Virginia, here-inafter for convenience styled the Railway Company, party of the first part; and

COUNTY OF SHELBY, Alabama, a municipal corporation of the State of Alabama, hereinafter for convenience styled the County, party of the second part;

## WITNESSETH:

unto moving them, do hereby mutually covenant and agree that, effective as of the 25 day of February , 1953, the agreement, in writing, heretofore made and entered into by and between them, dated July 28, 1952, concerning highway encroachments, at or near ALDRICH, DOGWOOD, RYAN and MAYLENE, in the County of Shelby and State of Alabama, as described in said agreement, shall be, and the same hereby is, modified and amended in the following manner, but not otherwise, that is to say:

By the incorporation in said agreement of July 28, 1952, of an additional paragraph in Article one (1), designated as (e), reading as follows:

"(e) To construct and maintain upon the southeasterly side of the right of way or property of the Railway Company, at or near NCMEN, in the County of Shelby and State of Alabama, a portion of a County road to extend from survey station 1374 + 46 to survey station 1376 + 50, located substantially as shown in red outline on blueprint of Drawing No. 30172, dated August 28, 1952, hereunto annexed and made a part hereof."


