Moore has resided on said property all of the time since the house was erected until the present, with the exception of a short period when he rented the premises; affiant further states that for a period of more than twenty years last past no person or parties other than the above named have been in possession of the above described property or excercised any claim to it, more particularly neither T. J. Peter nor his heirs, nor the Southern Mineral Land Company, nor the Alabama Carbon Company, nor Climax Coal Company, nor the Alabama Iron & Steel Company, nor Seaman D. Brown, nor John P. Figh, nor John T.
