I, the undersigned W. B. Blevins, Town Clerk of the Town of Calera, Alabama hereby certify that at a meeting of the Mayor and Town Council, of the Town of Calera, held in the Town of Calera on the 25th day of april, 1953 the following resolution was duly presented, seconded and adopted:

"Be it resolved by the Town Council, the governing body of the Town of Calera, Alabama that the vacation of streets and alleys hereinafter set forth, as declared by the abutting property owners be and the same is by the governing body of the Town of Calera assented and agreed to and such streets, portions of streets and alleys are hereby declared to be vacated and forever closed to public use; namely, as follows: That part of Rose Lake Drive beginning on the Eastern boundary of 18th Street and extending in an Eastwardly direction to a point on the North side of said drive which is 40 feet South of the North boundary line of Lot 10, in Block D, and on the South boundary of said drive to the Northwest corner of Lot 13, in Block 0; Patricia Place from the East boundary line of 18th Street to the West boundary line of 16th Street; Woodbine Avenue from the center of 16th Street Eastward to the Western boundary of 14th Street; 17th Street from the North line of Woodbine Avenue to Rose Lake Drive; 15th Street from the Southern Railroad to the South line of 11th Avenue and 14th Street from the Southern Railroad Northward to the South boundary line of Woodbine Avenue; all alleys running through Blocks 18, 0, P, U and T, all within the limits of the Town of Calera.
