WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, Warrant No. 34,704 for 140 acres, in favor of Joseph S. Butcher,
Private Captain Robinson's Company, Alabama Militia, Creek War

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the East half of the North East quarter and the North East quarter of the South East quarter of Section Eleven, in Township twenty four of Range eleven East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing One hundred and twenty acres and forty and one half hundredths of an acre

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL the said tract having been assigned by the said Joseph S. Butcher to Joseph R. John in whose favor said tract has been located

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Joseph R. John as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Joseph R. John as assignee as aforesaid and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
