WHEREAS, Robert W. Barton, of Bill County,

has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Sacramento,

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1830, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

the West half of the North-east quarter of section twenty-one, in Township twenty-four of Range

eleven in the district of lands offered for sale at Washoe, Nevada, containing eighty

acres, and fifty-five hundredths of an acre,

according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-

chased by the said Robert W. Barton.

NOW KNOW YE, that the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several

acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said Robert W. Barton,

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appur-

tenances, of whatever nature thereto belonging, unto the said Robert W. Barton,

and to his heirs and assigns forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, John Quincy Adams,

PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto

affixed.
