Whereas, Solomon Johnson of Rich County has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Muscatine, Iowa, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Solomon Johnson according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th April, 1830, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the North West quarter of the South East quarter of Section Twenty one, in Township Twenty four, of Range Eleven east, in the District of Iowa, subject to sale at Muscatine, Iowa, containing forty acres and twenty eight hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Solomon Johnson

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such cases made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said Solomon Johnson and to his heirs, the said tract above described:

To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Solomon Johnson
