Whereas, Salmon Johnson the son of the said John M. Johnson

had deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Salt Lake City, Utah, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Salmon Johnson

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

the tract of land of the north-west quarter of section twenty-two in Township thirty-four north Range eleven east, in the District of Utah opened for sale at Salt Lake City, Utah, containing forty acres and more hereinafter shown according to the official plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Salmon Johnson

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several

acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said Salmon Johnson the said land the said tract above described: So Have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereto belonging, unto the said Salmon Johnson and his heirs and assigns forever.
