the North East quarter of Section twenty six, in Township twenty four of Range Eleven East, in the District of Land subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing One hundred and sixty acres and sixty four hundredths of an acre,

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said Isaac N. Campbell.

United States of America, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Isaac N. Campbell

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Isaac N. Campbell

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
