whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Lovelady and King, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the West half of the North west quarter of Section nineteen, in Township twenty-four, of Range twelve, East, in the District of lands offered for sale at Muskogee, Alabama, containing eighty acres, and seventy-four and one hundredth of an acre, according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Lovelady and King.

**NOW KNOW YE**, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said William Lovelady and King, <sup>his heirs and assigns forever</sup>, the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereto belonging, unto the said William Lovelady, his heirs and assigns forever.

PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
