THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, William Lovelady, in his own right, and as a partner of Edmund King (of the firm of Lovelady & King) has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Washington, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Lovelady and King, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the West half of the North west quarter of Section nineteen, in Township twenty-four, Range twelve, East, in the District of lands offered for sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing eighty acres, and Survey-Lot and one hundredth of an acre, according to the official plan of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, unless said tract has been purchased by the said Lovelady and King.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said William Lovelady, and to his heirs, the said tract above described. To Bear and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatever nature thereto belonging, unto the said William Lovelady, and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, John Quincy Adams, President of the United States, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be affixed.
