Whereas James Madison, of like County,
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Shreveport,
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said James Madison
according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
the West half of the North West quarter of Section twenty, in Township twenty four of Range twelve East in the
District of Louisiana subject to sale at Shreveport, Louisiana, containing eighty acres and twelve increments of an acre
according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-
chased by the said James Madison

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the
several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said James Madison
to have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatever nature, thence belonging unto the said
James Madison
