My name is L. S. Demby. I am a resident of  
Jefferson County, Alabama and operate a farm  
in Shelby County, Alabama, belonging to my  
wife, Azalee Demby.  
Immediately after purchasing the tract from  
the Albright family I arranged to have J. R.  
McMillan, Shelby County Engineer (L.S. 419)  
survey the same and mark the corners for me.  
This was about the month of May 1943.

Following the survey I repaired all fences  
around said tract.

I found from the survey that an old house  
was on the south boundary line of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of
