Before me John Foshee, a Notary Public for said County in said State, personally appeared W.P. McConaughy, who after being duly sworn deposes and says as follows:

I am 83 years of age and have lived at Montevallo, Alabama, all of my life. Montevallo is located in Shelby County and about one mile from Wilton, Shelby County, Alabama. I am familiar with land described as follows:

The NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9 and all that part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8 that lies East and South of what was formerly known as the E.T.V. and G. Railroad. All of which is in Township 24 N, Range 12 E, Shelby County, Alabama.

Back in about the year of 1890 this land was part of a community known as Birmingham Junction. Later the community became known as Wilton and is now the Incorporated Town of Wilton, Alabama.

This affidavit is given to correct the description of property in a previous affidavit executed by me on the 6th day of August, 1953, recorded in Book 162, Page 78 of Deeds in the Office of Judge of Probate, Shelby County, Alabama.
