AFFIDAVIT

My name is Mrs. F. E. Horton. I am the wife of J. G. Horton and recall when my said husband and I conveyed the following described land to Willie Pears on September 3, 1912, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 79 Page 268 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. Said property conveyed being described as follows:

The $S\frac{1}{2}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ and $S\frac{1}{2}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$, less 3 acres in NW corner all in Section 32, Township 21, Range 1 West, containing in all 37 acres;
Also the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5, Township 22, Range 1 West, 20 acres;
situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

I am informed that said deed which we executed was made to Willie Pears. I know this was a typographical error, as I know Willie Pierce purchased said land and went into possession of it and lived on it until he and his wife conveyed the same to W. D. Bearden on November 15, 1915, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 59 Page 37 in said Probate Office.
