Dear Sirs: Re: Cutting of Danger Timber on Bessemer-Lay Dam 44 and 110

KV Lines

It is our understanding that during the past few years you gentlemen have acquired title to the northeast quarter of northwest quarter of Section 4, Township 20 South, Range 3 West, Shelby County, Alabama, from the Tennessee Coal and Iron Company.

Alabama Power Company has several transmission lines crossing this property. The right to install these lines was obtained by the Power Company from the Tennessee Company by agreement dated September 10, 1914. Under the terms of the agreement which run with the land, Alabama Power Company is required to pay the property owner the reasonable market value of all of the danger trees cut outside of the cleared right of way. Under the terms of this agreement it is also necessary for Alabama Power Company to obtain permission to do this prior to the cutting of the trees.

Our Operating forces have recently informed us that it is necessary to reclear the right of way and cut the danger trees outside of the strip at the present time. They have cruised this right of way and find that the following trees will necessarily be cut in this reclearing operation:
