Before the undersigned authority, personally appeared R. G. Carden who is known to me and who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says:

I am acquainted with that portion of the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, Township 19, Range 1 East lying South of what is known as the Weldon and Harpersville Road and that portion of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section lying South of said Road.

Supplementing my affidavit in reference to this land filed for record on November 10, 1949 and recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County Alabama in Deed Book 141 at page 128, I certify that acting as agent for my wife I erected on this property a dwelling house in 1941 and rented it out to tenants continuously until my wife and I deeded to Joe Foreman by deed dated in 1944. Mr. Foreman went into possession of the land immediately upon execution of the above mention deed, living in the dwelling house thereon until he sold and deeded it to C. A. Belew and Virginia Belew on January 7, 1946. The Belews, immediately upon execution of the last mentioned deed went into possession of said property, repaired the dwelling house, and lived in it continuously until the present time except for about 2 years in which the Belews had tenants occupying the house.

Therefore, from the time I erected the house on the property down to the present time it has been in actual, open, notorious, continuous, exclusive, hostile and adverse possession of my wife and her successors in title who lived upon the property, claiming to own it.
