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All being situated in Shelby County, Alabama; less and except such highway rights of way and such railroads rights of way as may exist on and over said above described lands.

I have been well acquainted with the location, ownership and possession of said above described lands for the past 23 years and more and I know that said land is now in the actual and peaceable possession of Southern Mineral Land Corporation, a corporation.

From about November 1929 to Sept. 1932 my father, John B. Broadhead was agent for Southern Mineral Land Company and he was in charge of the above described lands as the overseer thereof and I often went with him on and over said lands checking on the land lines and making investigations to see whether or not there were any fires or any trespassing upon this land. During the entire time I have known this land the boundary lines of the same have been clearly marked by Southern Mineral Land Corp. and their title and possession to said property have not been disputed during said period of time. I have been well acquainted with the above lands since November, 1929.

In or about September 1932 I succeeded my father, John B. Broadhead, as the agent for Southern Mineral Land Company in Bibb County, Alabama, and it became my duty to oversee and look after and take care of the above described lands and after Southern Mineral Land Company went into bankruptcy and was succeeded by Southern Mineral Land Corporation, continued on in such capacity in the employ of Southern Mineral Land Corporation and I served in such capacity until about March 1935 when I was succeeded in this job by Mr. Charles Morgan. During the entire period in which I served as such agent and overseer of the above lands I regularly patrolled and walked and rode over all of said land and checked on the land lines and made certain that no one was trespassing upon this land. I went over this land several times each year during the time I was overseer and I know that all land lines showing the boundaries of the Southern Mineral Land Corporation land above described were clearly marked and there was no dispute concerning the same. Since March 1935 I also have been well acquainted with the above described lands while they were being looked after by Mr. Charles Morgan, as agent and overseer of Southern Mineral Land Corporation, and by Mr. D. W. Litton, who succeeded Mr. Charles Morgan as such agent and overseer for Southern Mineral Land Corporation upon the death of Mr. Morgan in 1947.

I know that Southern Mineral Land Corporation, a corporation, now owns all of the above described lands and is now in the peaceable, adverse, actual, notorious and undisputed possession of said lands. All of the above described lands are generally known in the Brierfield community and elsewhere as being the property of Southern Mineral Land Corporation. Southern Mineral Land Corporation, a corporation, and those through whom it claims title have, to my own personal knowledge and experience, been in the actual, adverse, open, notorious, peaceable, undisputed and continuous possession of all of the above described lands since 1929 and on up through the date this affidavit is executed and said adverse possession and ownership to my knowledge cover the period of time of more than 23 years immediately preceding the date of this affidavit. During said period of time said Southern Mineral Land Corporation and those through whom they claim title have continuously and regularly properly assessed said land for taxes in their name and they have paid all taxes due thereon, and they have marked and painted their land lines so there would be no mistake on any one's part as to the land they owned and were claiming and their employees and agents have several times each year walked over and they have ridden over and checked all of this land to be certain no one was trespassing upon the same and also to be certain no fire was burning on any of it. I have been living for quite a number of years within a very short distance of the greater majority of the above described lands and if there had been any dispute about the title of Southern Mineral Land Corporation I feel certain that I would know about it. About 1935 or 1936 I went all over this land with Charles Morgan, Agent for Southern Mineral Land Corporation and helped him paint all the corners and land lines of the land owned by Southern Mineral Land Corporation.
