in deed Book 162 at page 544. This deed carries the same description
as the other 2 deeds.

Prior to November 10, 1948, Mr. Parker and I were divorced and
my husband on that date was Curtis C. Smith. I have since been
divorced from Mr. Curtis C. Smith and my present husband is

J. J. Caruso. I do not know of his whereabouts, as I haven't seen nor
heard from him since July, 1953.
