I am acquainted with tract #15 of the survey and map of Jessica Ingram of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31, Township 18, Range West, Shelby County, Alabama as recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama in Map Book 3 at page 55.

My husband Chalma H. Parker and I purchased this land from Jessica Ingram and on the 30th day of April, 1946 obtained a deed therefore, which is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama in Deed Book 125 at page 431.

In the aforementioned deed the land was merely described as follows:

Tract #15 of 5 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31, Township 18, Range 1 West, Shelby County, Alabama, and no mention was made to the survey.

Chalma H. Parker, my husband deeded me his 1/2 interest in the land on the 10th day of May, 1948 and this deed bears the same description as the former deed.

On the 19th day of November, 1948, my husband Curtis C. Smith and I executed a deed conveying the property to M. W. Ogles and this deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama in deed Book 162 at page 544. This deed carries the same description as the other 2 deeds.

Prior to November 10, 1948, Mr. Parker and I were divorced and my husband on that date was Curtis C. Smith. I have since been divorced from Mr. Curtis C. Smith and my present husband is

J. J. Caruso. I do not know of his whereabouts, as I haven't seen nor heard from him since July, 1953.
