Smith, in consideration of the sum of ONE THOUSAND and NO/100 DOLLARS, and other valuable consideration paid, in hand paid by James Ottie Anderson, ^{Sr.} the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we do bargain, sell, set over, and deliver to the said James Ottie Anderson ^{Sr.;} the following goods, chattels, merchandise, cattle, hogs, crops, hay, seed, wire, and other personal property, to wit:

- 1 Hereford Bull, registered, white faced, horns point down, aged approximately, three years, named KING;
2. 1 Black Cow with white butterfly in forehead, has had second calf, and is now bred;
3. One (1) Blue Cow, first calf, now bred;
4. 1 Red Cow, first calf, bred;
5. 1 Cow, Black Mulley, black teats, second calf;
6. 1 white and black Cow, second calf;
7. 1 Red short horn cow, first calf, bred.
8. 1 Mulley headed cow, black, white belly, second calf, now bred;
