Declaration of Vacation of a Portion of Blocks 253 and 264 Of the Map and Survey of Calera

As hereinafter referred to, the "Map and Survey of Calera" has reference to that map or survey of the Town of Calera, Shelby County, Alabama, which was made by John H. Dunstan, Engineer, on 1 October 1886, and which map or survey was never recorded in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, although there are several printed copies in existence. A copy of the portion of the said Map and Survey of Calera which is affected by this declaration of vacation is attached hereto and marked "Exhibit A".

We, the undersigned, being all of the owners of the lots and lands abutting on those certain streets or alleys shown in the Map and Survey of Calera known and designated on the map or plat thereof as that portion of a twenty-foot street or alley running North and South a distance of 200 feet and lying immediately South of Twenty-first Avenue and the twenty-foot street or alley running North and South a distance of 190 feet and lying North of Twenty-first Avenue, the said streets or alleys being more particularly described as follows:

20-Foot Alley in Block 264: As the point of beginning, begin at the Southeast corner of Lot 9 of Block 264 of said Map and Survey of Calera and run northerly along the East boundary line of Lots 9, 8, 7, and 6 of said Block 264 a distance of 190 feet to the Northeast corner of Lot 6; thence run easterly along the North boundary line of Block 264 a distance of 20 feet to the Northwest corner of Lot 4; thence run southerly along the West boundary line of Lots 4, 3, 2, and 1 a distance of 190 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot 1; thence run westerly along the North boundary line of Twenty-first Avenue a distance of 20 feet to the point of beginning.

Portion of 20-Foot Alley in Block 253: As the point of beginning, begin at the Southeast corner of Lot 12 of said Block 253 of said Map and Survey of Calera and run northerly along the East boundary line of Lots 12, 11, 10, and 9 a distance of 200 feet to the Northeast corner of Lot 9; thence run Easterly along the South boundary line of Twenty-first Avenue a distance of 20 feet to the Northwest corner of Lot 8; thence run southerly along the West boundary line of Lots 8, 7, 6, and 5 a distance of 200 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot 5; thence run westerly along a line parallel to the South boundary line of Twenty-first Avenue a distance of 20 feet to the point of beginning.

do hereby make this declaration and do hereby declare both of or portions thereof said streets or alleys/as described above vacated and annulled in their entirety. The vacation of the said streets or alleys of the said Map and Survey of Calera is in compliance with Section 17, Titlé 56, Code of Alabama of 1940.

Convenient means of ingress and egress to and from their property are afforded to all other property owners owning property in the tract of land embraced in the said Map and Survey of Calera by other streets or alleys in existence, and also by other streets or alleys being dedicated by the undersigned Bart T.

Skelton and his wife, Ruby H. Skelton, in a resubdivision of a portion of said Block 264 and a portion of the said Block 253 of the Map and Survey of Calera, a map or plat of which will be placed upon record in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, upon the vacation of the said streets or alleys hereimabove described.

This vacation is made for the purpose of destroying the force and effect of the dedication by the map, plat or survey known as the Map and Survey of Calera and to divest all public rights, including any rights which may have been acquired by prescription in that part of the streets or alleys aforementioned, thus to make possible a resubdivision by the undersigned Bart T. Skelton and Ruby H. Skelton of a portion of said Block 264 and a portion of said Block 253. The said streets or alleys being vacated hereby have not been used by the public and are unimproved.

The vacation of the said portion of the said Map and Survey of Calera being within the corporate limits of the City of Calera, County of Shelby, State of Alabama, a municipality of the said State, the assent of the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Calera, Alabama, to the vacation of the said portion of the said Map and Survey of Calera has been obtained and is evidenced by a resolution of the said Mayor and Aldermen of the said City of Calera, Alabama, a copy of which said resolution duly certified to by the City Clerk of the said City is attached hereto.




EXHIBIT A

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALERA

WHEREAS, all of the owners of the lots and lands abutting on those certain streets or alleys shown in the Map and Survey of Calera known and designated on the map or plat thereof as a 20-foot-street or alley running North and South a distance of 200 feet lying immediately South of Twenty-first Avenue and the twenty-foot street or alley running North and South a distance of 190 feet and lying North of Twenty-first Avenue, the said streets or alleys being more particularly described as follows:

20-Foot Alley in Block 264: As the point of beginning, begin at the Southeast corner of Lot 9 of Block 264 of said Map and Survey of Calera and run northerly along the East boundary line of Lots 9, 8, 7, and 6 of said Block 264 a distance of 190 feet to the Northeast corner of Lot 6; thence run easterly along the North boundary line of Block 264 a distance of 20 feet to the Northwest corner of Lot 4; thence run southerly along the West boundary line of Lots 4, 3, 2, and 1 a distance of 190 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot 1; thence run westerly along the North boundary line of Twenty-first Avenue a distance of 20 feet to the point of beginning.

Portion of 20-Foot Alley in Block 253: As the point of beginning, begin at the Southeast corner of Lot 12 of said Block 253 of said Map and Survey of Calera and run northerly along the East boundary line of Lots 12, 11, 10, and 9 a distance of 200 feet to the Northeast corner of Lot 9; thence run Easterly along the South boundary line of Twenty-first Avenue a distance of 20 feet to the Northwest corner of Lot 8; thence run southerly along the West boundary line of Lots 8, 7, 6, and 5 a distance of 200 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot 5; thence run westerly along a line parallel to the South boundary line of Twenty-first Avenue a distance of 20 feet to the point of beginning.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Calera, Alabama, composed of the Mayor and Aldermen, in a regular meeting assembled, the assent of the City Council of the City of Calera be, and it hereby is, given to the vacation and annullment of the above mentioned streets or alleys as shown on the Map and Survey of Calera; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the City of Calera be, and he hereby is, authorized to present a copy of this Resolution duly certified as correct by him to the owners of the lots and lands abutting on the said streets or alleys described above so that the same may be attached to and fe filed and recorded with their legal declaration of the vacation of the said streets or alleys.
