the receipt whereof is acknowledged we the said T.F. Prestridge and wife,
Alice Prestridge do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said
Delmar P. Williams and wife, Marguerite Williams,

the following described real estate situated in SHELBY County, Ala., to-wit: That certain
parcel of land described as commencing at the Northeast corner of the
Southwest Quarter of Section 23, Township 21, Range 3 West, and run
thence South along the East line of said Quarter Section a distance
of 550 feet; run thence West a distance of 790 feet, more or less, to
the East right of way line of the Montevallo and Ashville paved Highway,
for a point of beginning of the property herein described and conveyed:
