It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the Register of this Court cause a copy of this decree to be placed of record in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, and that the recording fee be taxed as a part of the cost in this cause.

It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the cost in this proceeding be and the same is hereby taxed against complainant, the Coosa River Newsprint Company, a corporation, for which let execution issue.
