Commissioner T. R. Nash introduced the following resolution:

RESOLUTION

Whereas, on August 10, 1943, Shelby County attempted to convey to J. S. Hartsfield, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 117 Page 257 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, the following described land:

All that portion of land east of Birmingham and Columbiana Public road being 15 acres, more or less, being a part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 20, Range 1 West, Shelby County, Alabama.

Whereas, said conveyance was defectively made and the Shelby County Board of Revenue and Control desires to correct the same;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SHELBY COUNTY BOARD OF REVENUE AND CONTROL, AS FOLLOWS:

That the Probate Judge of Shelby County, Alabama, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to execute a conveyance conveying to the said J. S. Hartsfield, all right, title and interest which said Shelby County does now or has heretofore owned in the following described land:

All that part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 20, Range 1 West, lying east of the Columbiana-Chelsea paved road; being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

Commissioner Offie Stinson moved that the foregoing resolution be adopted as introduced and read, which motion was seconded by Commissioner Fred McClendon and upon roll call all members of the Board present voted in favor of said motion. Thereupon said presiding officer declared said motion/^{carried} and said resolution adopted.
