whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Samuel M. Chandler according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands;" for the said half of the tract the first given in petition have withdrawn about four of range twelve East in the northwest corner of said tract at the same place as above, containing twenty nine acres and thirty seven hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Samuel M. Chandler.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said Samuel M. Chandler, his heirs and assigns forever, the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatever nature thereto belonging, unto the said Samuel M. Chandler and to his heirs and assigns forever.
