AFFIDAVIT

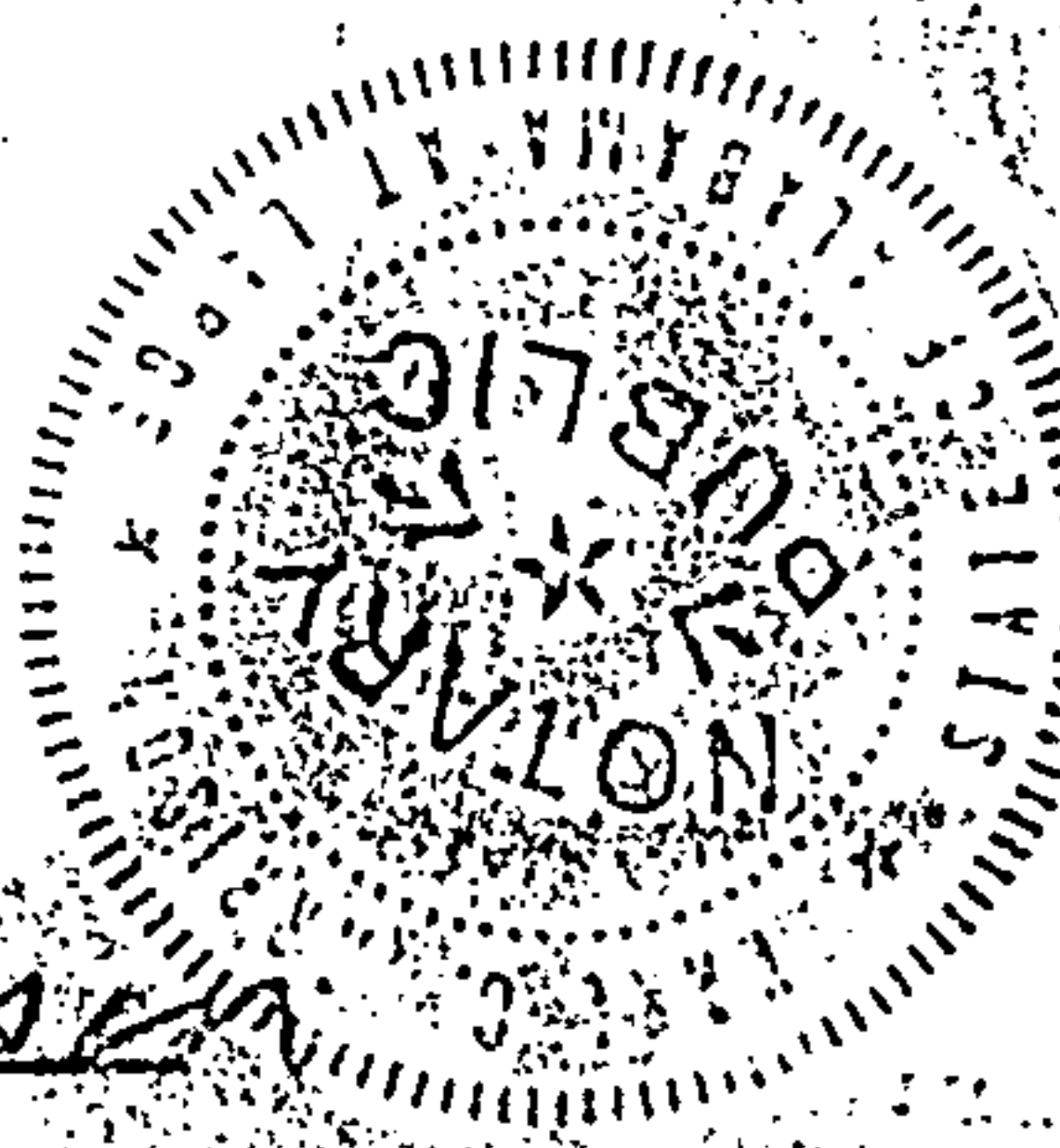
