I am acquainted with the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 18,
Township 20, Range 2 West, Shelby County, Alabama. I never did own
any of this forty except a one acre tract in the SW corner thereof.
On September 24, 1947, L. C. Colum executed a deed to Pearl Collum and
me. All we ever went into possession of was the one acre tract in the
SW corner of the forty above described. My wife and I never claimed any
other property under said deed executed as above described.

My wife and I deeded to Jimmy Martin about a year ago and he went into possession of the one acre tract of land and is not claiming any other land except that one acre.

I am acquainted with Virgil C. Collum and he never did own any part of the  $NE^{\frac{1}{4}}$  of the  $SW^{\frac{1}{4}}$  of said Section 18 and was never in possession of any of it.

This one acre tract was deeded to Pearl Collum, my wife, and to me in 1947 and there seems to have been a misdescription in the deed because no part of this one acre lies in the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of said Section 18, lies wholly in the SW corner of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of said Section 18.

Immediately after execution of the deed in 1947 above referred to we went into possession of this one acre and built a house on it and lived upon the one acre tract of land until 1953 when we deeded it to Jimmy Martin or James Martin.
