



I am acquainted with the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 18, Township 20, Range 2 West, Shelby County, Alabama and have known this land for 25 years.

Virgil C. Collum against whom the United States Government has a recorded tax lien which is recorded in Judgment Book E at page 296 in the Probate office of Shelby County, Alabama, dated November 5, 1948 and filed for record on November 9, 1948, never did own any of this land at all and was never in possession of it. Likewise, Leonard Collum, against whom tax lien is also recorded, never did own any part of the above described land except one acre in the SW corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 18, and was never in possession of any of said land except the one acre above described.
