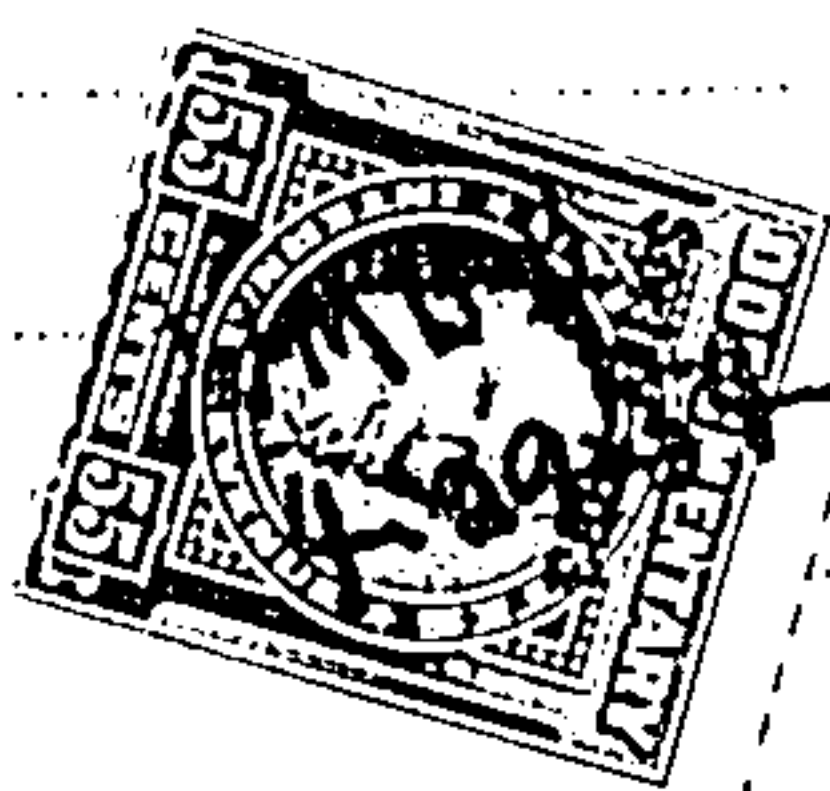


WARRANTY DEED

and husband Marvin J. Green do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Willie
Mae B. Green and husband Joel Elvin Green, share and share alike, for
and during their joint lives with the remainder over to the survivor,
his or her heirs or assigns in fee simple
the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Ala., to-wit: A part of
Tract #325 according to Pickett's Map of Calera, Alabama, described
as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the East boundary of
the Northwest Quarter of Southeast Quarter of Northwest Quarter of
Section 22, Township 22 South, Range 2 West, with the North boundary
of State Highway #25 and run in a westerly direction along the North
boundary of said Highway 107 feet for point of beginning of a lot
hereby conveyed; run thence North 3°21' West along the West boundary
of Mrs. Butterworth's lot 150 feet; turn thence an angle of 90° to
the left and run 75 feet; turn thence an angle of 90° to the left/to
the North boundary of said State Highway #25; run thence in a north-
easterly direction along the North boundary of said Highway 75 feet,

Green and husband Joel Elvin Green, their heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.

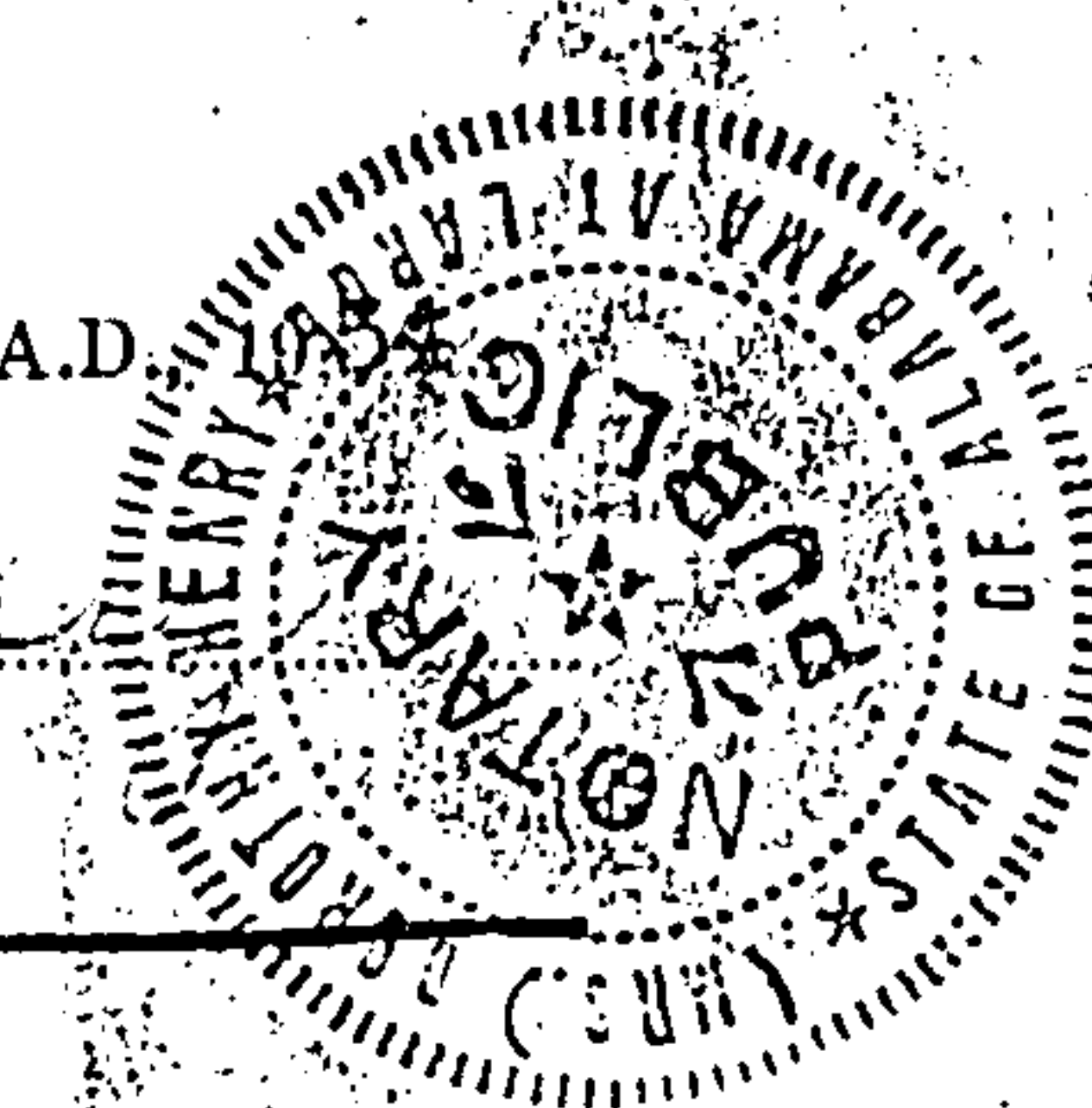
