On Nay 8, 1939, according to the deed, I paid him all of the purchase price except \$83.56, for which I gave him my note. I got the money in trading in cattle and hogs and other activities, in addition to what I already had. I paid the note to Mr. L. L. Carter in 1941 and have the note in my possession marked paid. The note was due on October 1, 1939 but I did not pay it on that date, but was late. The land is fully paid for and I do not owe anything on it.
