Before the undersigned authority personally appeared J. W. Glasgow who is known to me and who being by me first duly sworn deposes and says:

I am acquainted with the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, Township 20, Range 4 West, Shelby County, Alabama and have known the land further back than 1931. Mrs. Mammie Bennett obtained a deed to this land from Lawrence Albright in 1931 and this deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama in Deed Book 89 at page 434. Immediately after the execution of the last mentioned deed Mrs. Bennett took actual possession of said land and lived upon it and cultivated parts of it each and every year until her husband died and a very short time thereafter she deeded the land to G. C. Yarbrough in 1944. Yarbrough immediately thereafter deeded the property to Herbert H. Ash and Ola B. Ash and they lived on the land and cultivated a portion of it until they sold me that part lying South and East of a public road which runs across the property. They contracted to sell Martha Lou Garner that part of the forty North of the road and she has been living on it since April 2, 1952. From 1931 to the present time no other person, firm or corporation has had any possession of that part North of the road except Mrs. Bennett and her successors in title.

There is a railroad across the forty, but it is South of the road and is not on any part of the Forty North of the road.

A spring is referred to in some of the deeds in the chain of title to this forty, but that spring is South of the road and is on that part of the forty I bought from Mr. and Mrs. Ash.
