do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said James Arthur Johnson and wife, Irene  
Johnson

the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Ala., to-wit:

That certain tract of land described as beginning at the Northwest corner of Lot No. 10, in Block "A", according to Byer's Survey and Map of Sterrett, Alabama, which point marks the Westernmost corner of Block "A", and which said point is the intersection of a Northerly line of Pine Street with the Southerly line of May Street, and run thence in a Southeasterly direction along the Northerly line of Pine Street a distance of 297.5 feet to the point of beginning and starting point of the lot herein described and conveyed; run thence at a right angle in a Northeasterly direction a distance of 55 feet to the point of intersection with the West right-of-way line of Public Highway No. 21; run thence in Southeasterly direction along the West right-of-way line of said Highway, a distance of 190 feet; run thence in a Northwesterly direction along the North right-of-way line of Pine Street, a distance of 180 feet to the starting point of the lot herein described and conveyed, and containing one-eighth (1/8) of an acre, more or less, and situated in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 19, Township 18, Range 2 East.
