Received of the AMERICAN TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY One Hundred Twenty and no/100 Dollars, in consideration of which the undersigned hereby grant and convey unto said Company, its associated and allied companies, its and their respective successors, assigns, lessees and agents, a right of way and easement to construct, operate, maintain, replace and remove a communication system consisting of such poles, fixtures, guys, anchors, wires, cables, testing-terminals, conduits, manholes, markers and other appurtenances, as the grantees may from time to time require, upon, across, over and under the land which the undersigned own or in which the undersigned have any interest in Section 2 (E 1/2 of NE 1/4

Tp. 21 S, 23 Range 3 W, County of Shelby, and State of Alabama and upon, along, over and under the roads, streets and highways adjoining the said land, together with the following rights: Of ingress and egress over and across the lands of the undersigned to and from said system for the purpose of exercising the rights herein granted; to install gates in any fences crossing said system; to cut down and keep cut down all trees and undergrowth within fifty feet of said system and any trees that may reach said system in falling; to permit the attachment of and to carry in said system the wires, cables, circuits and appurtenances of any other company; and, when said system is located on the highway, to relocate the said system to permit highway widening. The undersigned for its self, its ~~XXXXXXX~~ administrators, successors and assigns, hereby covenant that no inflammable structure shall be erected or permitted on said land within fifty feet of said system. Grantees agree to pay for damage to fences and growing crops arising from the construction and maintenance of the aforesaid system.

Minutes of a meeting of the County Board of

A meeting of the County Board of Education of Shelby County, Alabama, held pursuant to the preceding call of the President, was held in the office of the Superintendent on June 22, 1954. The meeting was called to order by the President and on roll call the following answered present:

A.C.Adams, N.Y.Horn and H.M.Johnson.

Absent: Cecil Cowart and Mrs. Signa McGraw.

The president declared a quorum present and proceeded with the order of business which included the adoption of the following motion.

A motion by H.M.Johnson and seconded by N.Y.Horn was unanimously adopted authorizing Superintendent W.W.Elliott to grant a right of way on the Siluria Negro School Property for the price of \$120 to the American Telephone and Telegraph Company.
