Goodwin cut the timber on said lands and built roads on the lands and kwikk hauled timber from the lands. I know of my own personal knowledge that Mr. J. H. Wilder claamed the said lands as his own. and I was sawhilling during the years that Mr. Wilder owned these lands and Mr. Wilder would not sell us the lands and we could only cut timber on lands surrounding these lands. Mr. Wilder claimed these lands as his own and held them openly and notoriously against all the world. I know of my own personal knowledge that these lands are not fit for homesteading as the lands are very hilly and are not fit for anything except growing timber, consequently I do not . have any knowledge of anyone living on the lands. There is a big hill going right through the middle of the Southeast guarter of Section 16, Township 18, Range 2, East.
