N. Curlee, in hand paid by R. L. Merrell the receipt whereof is acknowledged, we the said W. E. Curlee and wife, Nannie C. Curlee; Franklin Martin Jordan, a widower; William Franklin Jordan and wife, Neutie Beatrice Jordan; and Elywn Jordan and wife, Mavis Jordan do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said R. L. Merrell the following described real estate, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:
