WHEREAS *William Legadale of Shelby County* has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *William Legadale* according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 29th of April, 1889, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" for the South East quarter of the South West quarter of Section eighteen, in Township eighteen of Range two East in the District of Land subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama, containing forty acres and five hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said *William Legadale*

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in that case made and provided have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said *William Legadale* So have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatever nature, heretofore belonging unto the said *William Legadale* and to his heirs and assigns forever

That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in that case made and provided have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said *William Legadale* So have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatever nature, heretofore belonging unto the said *William Legadale* and to his heirs and assigns forever
