WHEREAS *Elizabeth M. Sterrett, Samuel B. Roper, and Walter C. Roper, of Shelby County, Alabama,*
have deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at *Tuscaloosa,* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Elizabeth M. Sterrett, Samuel B. Roper, and Walter C. Roper,* according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for *the West half of the South East quarter of Section Eight, in Township Twenty one, of Range One, West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, containing Eighty acre, and thirty nine hundredths of an acre,*

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract have been purchased by the said *Elizabeth M. Sterrett, Samuel B. Roper, and Walter C. Roper.*

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said *Elizabeth M. Sterrett, Samuel B. Roper, and Walter C. Roper,* and to their heirs, the said tract above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, therunto belonging, unto the said *Elizabeth M. Sterrett, Samuel B. Roper, and Walter C. Roper,* and to their heirs and assigns forever.
