To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas Philip D. Davis of New Haven, Connecticut, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Indianapolis, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Philip D. Davis according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands"; for the Grant of Six Hundred and Sixty Acres of Section Sixteen, in the Township Twenty One, of McRae Range, one mile west, in the District of Indiana, subject to Sale at Indianapolis, Indiana;

Containing forty acres and a half, more or less, of land, a half hour's distance from the Survey, according to the official plan of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been surveyed by the said Philip D. Davis.

Now know ye, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the services and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Philip D. Davis and to his heirs the said tract above described, to have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said and to his heirs and assigns forever.
