To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas Philip D. Lewis of Shelby County, Alabama, had deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Philip D. Lewis according to the provisions of the Act of April 1839, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the said land quarter of the South East quarter of section seven, in Township twenty one, Range one West in the District of Alabama subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing forty acres more or less, and a half section of an acre (approximately) according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Philip D. Lewis
