Grantees agree to pay for damage to fences and growing crops arising from the construction and maintenance of the aforesaid system. 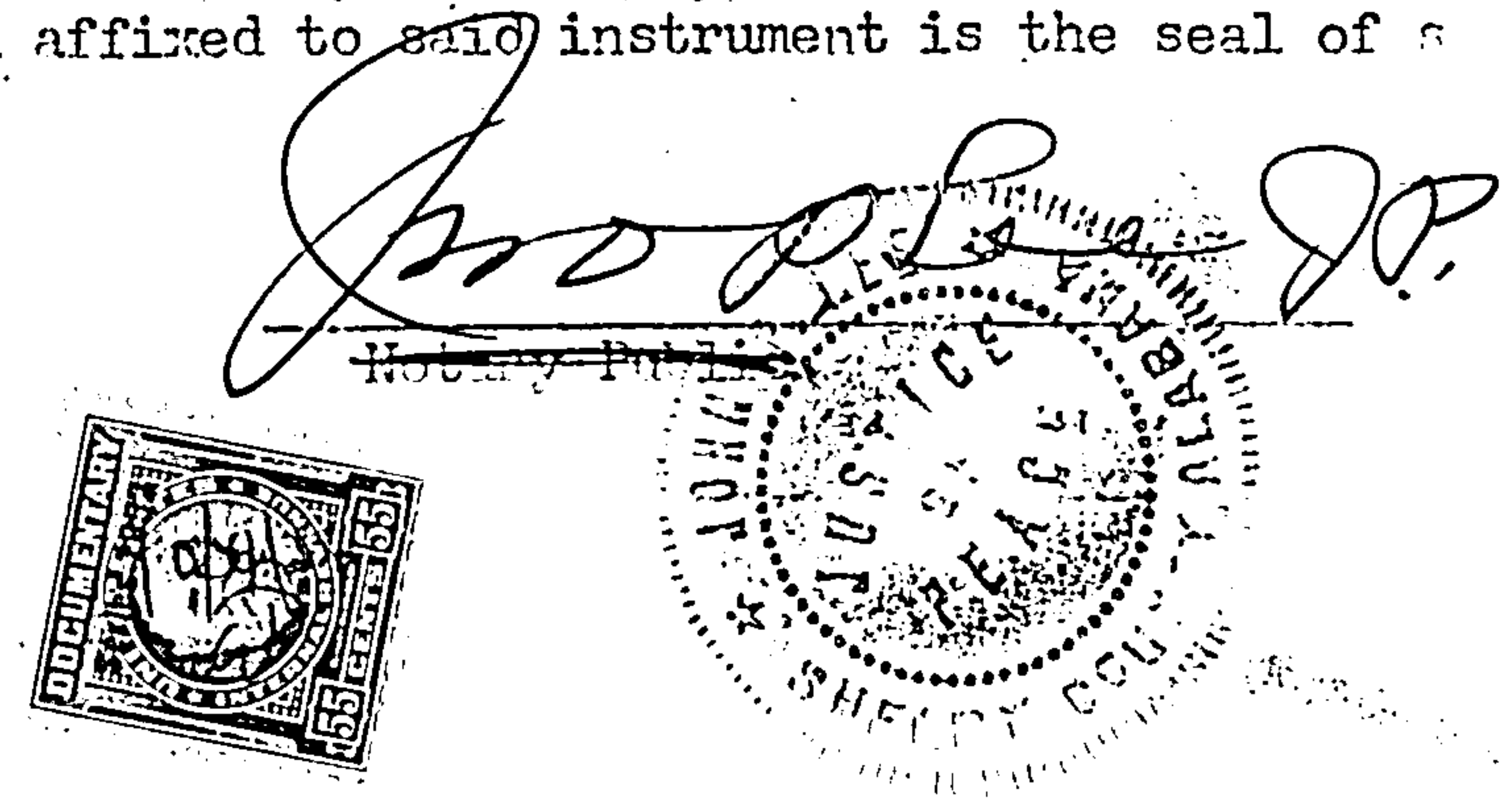
