Containing 3.02 acres.

My mother, Mrs. S. J. Albright was the owner of and was in possession of this land which comprised a part of a three hundred acre tract of land from 1906 to the time of her death, and during all that time the entire farm was under fence, including the 3.02 acres. After my mother's death my father, J. A. Albright remained in possession of the farm and during all that time it was fenced up, including the 3.02 acre tract of land. After my father died, my mother's heirs divided up the land and this 3.02 acre tract was deeded to me as a part of my interest in the estate.
