do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Will McKinzie and wife, Vera McKinzie

as joint tenants, with right of survivorship, the following described real estate; situated in

Shelby

County, Alabama, to-wit: Begin at the Southwest

corner of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter, Section 11, Township 19 South, Range 2 East; thence North $6^{\circ} 45'$ East a distance of 67.3 feet to a point; thence North $27^{\circ} 45'$ East a distance of 90.4 feet to a point; thence North $37^{\circ} 45'$ East a distance of 400 feet to a point on the old Glover's Ferry Road; thence North $76^{\circ} 15'$ East a distance of 112.5 feet to a point on said road; thence North $51^{\circ} 15'$ East a distance of 191 feet to a point on said road; thence North $64^{\circ} 45'$ East a distance of 70.9 feet to a point on said road; thence South $74^{\circ} 15'$ East a distance of 138.8 feet to a point on said road; thence South $71^{\circ} 0'$ East a distance of 399 feet to a point on said road; thence South $85^{\circ} 15'$ East a distance of 170 feet to a point on the East line of said forty; thence South $4^{\circ} 15'$ East a distance of 380 feet to a point which point is the Southeast corner of said forty; thence South $86^{\circ} 45'$ West a distance of 1331 feet to a point being the Southwest corner of said forty and the point of beginning.




