Personally appeared before me, the undersigned authority,  
one Homer Harper , who being by me first duly sworn, deposes  
and says:

My name is Homer Harper . I live at 1732 Arlington Avenue,  
Bessemer, Alabama . I am a son of J. C. Harper and Nancy E.  
Harper. After my father's death my brothers and sisters and I  
conveyed our interest in 80 acres of land in Shelby County, Alabama  
to my mother, Nancy E. Harper. The deeds were made in 1943. My  
mother did not own any other land in Shelby County except the 80  
acres described as the  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 16, Township 20,  
Range 1 West. The deeds of my brothers and sisters and mine executed  
in 1943 all contained a misdescription, but I know that it was the  
intention of all the heirs to convey the 80 acres above described,  
and none of the J. C. Harper heirs have claimed any interest in the  
above described land since my mother, Nancy E. Harper, sold and  
conveyed the land to Marvin Daw and Eula Mae Daw in 1943.


