 Shelby County That I Emanuel Wick a citizen

 House in Columbiana, in said County, at pub-
 lic outcry to the highest bidder, on twelve months
 credit, beginning of the purchase, note there for
 with interest from its date, having given
 and had notice of time, place & terms of said
 sale - That at said sale Joseph W. Crenshaw of
 said County, became & was the purchaser thereof
 to wit, the North East quarter of the North West quarter
 of Section 24, in Township 20 of Range and West
 excepting two & a half acres there of in the North East
 and also the West half of the North East quarter of said
 Section, Township & Range, and also the East half the
 South West quarter of Section 24, & the South half of the
 South East quarter of said Section 24, & the North half
 of the North East quarter of Section 25 in Township
 20 of Range and West. Said to be in said County for
